MMSI Chip & Sip Film & Book Series Presents


"WINDOW FISHING"





2024 Angela Pauling Memorial Scholarship Recipients


MS. BRIANNA WEBBER

2024 Angela Pauling Memorial Scholarship Recipients


MS. ALISSA SAUNDERS

MS. KHADIJA NDAO

Congratulations to Khadija Ndao, 2024 Recipient of the Angela Pauling Memorial Scholarship.

Ms. Ndao attended Harry S. Truman High School, Bronx, New York. Her school counselor writes that she seldom encounters a student as exceptionally prepared for college as Khadija and that "her academic achievements are nothing short of extraordinary" – Elizabeth Stout, School Counselor.

Ms. Ndao was a member of student government where she ensured the organization's effectiveness and that her peers' voices were heard. She demonstrated leadership in helping her school secure funding for student activities beyond the classroom. She actively participated in classroom collaborations while engaging in the Mock Trial and Moot Courts program where she researched established case law and precedents.



Ms. Ndao takes pride in serving as a peer leader in the Relationship Abuse Prevention Program and hopes to bring awareness to domestic violence. Her desire to bring awareness reached beyond school as she participated in the Bride March honoring the memory of victims of domestic violence. She was also actively involved in the community service organizations of the African Club, Gay-Straight Alliance, and BuildOn.

Ms. Ndao has been accepted at the University of Pennsylvania where she will major in political science and pursue a law degree. Her dream is to become an immigration attorney where she can continue her commitment to serving others. We look forward to hearing about her dreams coming to fruition.



Juneteenth, celebrated annually on June 19th, became a federal holiday in 2021 which commemorates the day the Union soldiers in Galveston, Texas enforced the Emancipation Proclamation & the last slaves learned they were free two and a half years after President Lincoln signed the proclamation.

For this holiday, we all owe a huge debt of thanks to Ms. Opal Lee (born October 7, 1926) who is known as the "Grandmother of Juneteenth". Ms. Lee is a Texas native, a retired teacher and an activist who worked for decades to make Juneteenth a federal holiday. To help promote the idea of the holiday, she (as a senior citizen) leads and walks in an

annual 2.5 mile walk (which represents the 2.5 years it took for the news of the Emancipation Proclamation to reach the state of Texas).

In 1939 on the significant date of June 19th, her childhood home was completely destroyed when she was 12 years old. Her parents bought the home that year in the mostly white area of Fort Worth, Texas. An angry mob of 500 white rioters showed up



at her home to protest against Black families moving into that area, so they vandalized and burned her home to the ground. Ms. Lee said, "The fact that this happened on the 19th day of June has spurred me to make people understand that Juneteenth is not just a festival."

This year, at the age of 97, and five days before Juneteenth was celebrated, Opal Lee moved into her new home on the same lot where her childhood home once stood. For many years she tried to find out who owned the plot of land. Ironically, Ms. Lee used to serve on the Board for Habitat for Humanity (Habitat) & she found out they owned the land. She tried to buy the land but Habitat would not sell it to her. Habitat gave her the land for free as well as plans to build a new home.

On May 3, 2024 Ms. Opal Lee was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President Joe Biden.
